

Update: Piezometer readings near future station locations

August 6, 2021

Following geotechnical investigations across the alignment of the future Millennium Line extension, the Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is returning to key locations to read the water levels with a special tool called a piezometer. Piezometers measure the below ground water levels in order to inform design and construction activities.

In order to minimize traffic disruptions, the work will be performed during non-peak hours around the future station locations at Great Northern Way – Emily Carr, Mount Pleasant, Broadway – City Hall, Oak-VGH, South Granville, and Arbutus, including side streets.

What to Expect



Timing

- As early as April 30 through fall 2021



Hours of Work

- 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday to Saturday
 - 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Sunday
- *Schedules can change without notice.*
**Some work may take place outside these hours as required*



Traffic

- A traffic truck with direction lights will inform of the lane shift, while crews take the piezometer reading.
- Short-term traffic lane shifts (about 15-minutes in duration) at the test locations.

Impacts/Interruptions

- Access to roads, properties, and businesses will be maintained.
- Temporary lane shifts while work is being performed.
- Work may be performed at night. The work at each location is expected to last about 15 minutes and will not be noisy.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.
