





## Traffic patterns are changing around the future South Granville Station Starting April 29 – Night Work

Note: The notice from Feb. 23, 2022 includes this work and we have updated scheduling, traffic details, and impacts to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the traffic deck. Starting April 29, traffic will shift onto the newly constructed traffic deck on the south side of W. Broadway between Hemlock and Granville streets. BSPC will then begin building the traffic deck on the north side of W. Broadway. The traffic deck is expected to be completed this summer.

The traffic shift and related works will be performed overnight to minimize the impact on businesses and residents. Work includes reconfiguring traffic signals and street lighting; paving; curb removal; line removal, line painting; and placement of barriers. Once completed, the traffic deck will maintain an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic configuration while station construction continues below W. Broadway.

## What to Expect

Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services. People in the area can expect congestion, reduced speed, and overnight turn restrictions on W. Broadway. Until the installation of the traffic deck, one lane in each direction will be maintained on W. Broadway from 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. Traffic will then be reduced to single lane alternating from 8 p.m. – 6 a.m. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Residents will also experience elevated noise during the work. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and using white noise-beepers on heavy construction vehicles where possible.
