





Traffic patterns continue to change around the future Arbutus Station in May – Night work on W. Broadway and on Arbutus St. begins May 14


Note: The notice from February 10, 2022 included this work and we now have current scheduling details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood continuing to prepare for the installation of the traffic deck between Arbutus and Cypress streets. While most preparatory work will be during the day and early evening, some work will be conducted overnight in order to implement traffic pattern shifts that require lane closures. The overnight work is expected to take place on May 14 with crews working between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

What to Expect


Throughout construction activities, access to residences, businesses, and parking lots is maintained. Residents and businesses in the area will experience elevated noise during this time. Work activities include but are not limited to the installation of concrete barriers, line painting, lighting and electrical work, road widening, excavation, and concrete placement. Traffic at intersections will be controlled by Traffic Control Personnel. The work area is shown in orange on the map below. Work will also take place in the intersections on W. Broadway at Maple St. and Cypress St. During this work, crosswalk access will change and a new crosswalk across Arbutus St. will be established south of W. Broadway at the laneway. Crosswalk access will also change at Maple St. and W. Broadway. The map below shows the new crosswalk routes at Arbutus St. and W. Broadway and Maple St. and W. Broadway in black. On May 14 only, traffic on Arbutus St. will be periodically reduced to single lane alternating. Once the traffic pattern shift is completed, traffic lanes will be located on the west side of Arbutus St.

We thank residents for their patience while we conduct the necessary work. People travelling in the area may experience some traffic congestion, periodic lane restrictions, sidewalk modifications and pedestrian detours around the work areas. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. BSPC will update the website with specific dates once timelines are confirmed.
