Broadway Subway Project Early Works - Utility Relocation near Cambie Street

WEEK OF DECEMBER 30: W. 8TH AVE., CAMBIE ST. TO ASH ST.

Early construction work is taking place in the Cambie St. and W. Broadway area, between December 2019 and March 2020, to relocate TELUS infrastructure in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project.


Beginning in the first week of January 2020, crews will be working in the intersection of Cambie St. and W. 8th Ave., and moving west on 8th Ave. towards Ash St. over the following weeks.

Please follow the direction of temporary signage and traffic control personnel on site.

Business and residential access will be maintained.

Work will take place in the southbound curb lane on Cambie St. and the eastbound curb lane on W. 8th Ave., in the following segments:

- 1. Intersection of Cambie St. and W. 8th Ave. (beginning early January)
- 2. South sidewalk of W. 8th Ave., moving west between Cambie St. and Ash St. (beginning mid-January)



Anticipated general work areas. Please note the work area depicted may not be exact, and the timing, location, and nature of work is subject to change.

Advance utility relocation near Cambie St. and W. Broadway is being undertaken in the following segments:

- Segment A: W. 10th Ave., between Cambie St. and Ash St.
- Segment B: North on Ash St. to W. Broadway
- Segment C: North on Ash St., crossing W. Broadway
- Segment D: North on Ash. St., W. Broadway to W. 8th Ave.
- Segment E: W. 8th Ave., Cambie Street to Ash Street
- Segment F: Intersection of W. 8th Ave. and Cambie St.
- Segment G: W. 10th Ave., crossing Cambie St.

Timing of this work is subject to change, and work in these segments may not necessarily be undertaken in sequence. The Broadway Subway Project is committed to keeping you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future so you can plan accordingly. Please note, construction schedules can change on short notice. Updates will be posted to the Project's website, emailed to local registered contacts, and additional notification will be provided where possible.

The Broadway Subway Project is a 5.7 km extension of the Millennium Line, from VCC-Clark Station to Broadway and Arbutus, and is being funded and delivered by the Province of B.C. with contributions from the Government of Canada and the City of Vancouver. It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
