





Night work to remove TBM conveyor belt components at Broadway-City Hall

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Broadway-City Hall Station. With tunnelling complete, work to remove the conveyor belt system and other infrastructure that supported the two tunnel boring machines is commencing. Crews will be intermittently removing the TBM infrastructure from the tunnels and transporting the components to the Broadway-City Hall Station site where they will be removed from the excavation by crane near the intersection of W. Broadway at Yukon Street.

Timing

- Starting on May 21 until the end of June, intermittent night work hours from 10 p.m. until 6 a.m.
- Typical hours of work are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m.

What to expect

- Some elevated noise related to crane activity and trucking of equipment.
- Intermittent temporary lane closures overnight or in off-peak hours.
- Lighting focused on work area to ensure crew safety.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, directing lights away from residential buildings, managing trucking routes to reduce the need for backing up when possible, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment when possible, and monitoring noisy activities so that measures can be adapted as needed. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
