

Construction ongoing at the future Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station

June 11, 2024

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the future Great Northern Way–Emily Carr Station. Following completion of tunnel boring activities, the TBMs’ conveyor belt infrastructure has been removed from the station and the excavation area dismantled, opening more space for station construction. Throughout 2024, work will continue to focus on constructing the underground station and station entrance building. This includes regular concrete pours for the walls, columns, concourse levels and roof sections. There is also work happening in the tunnels to prepare for track installation.

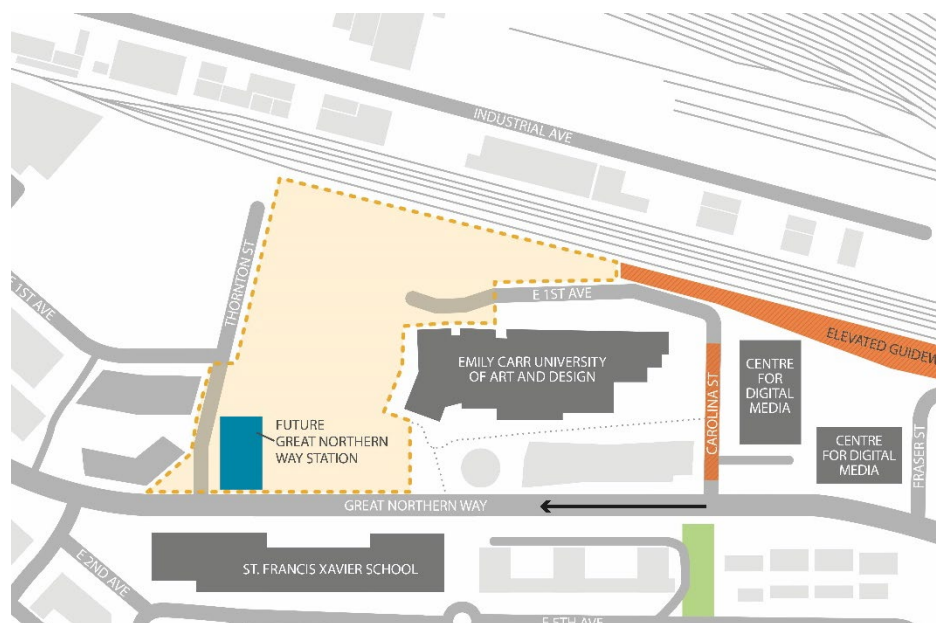
Timing

- Regular hours of work are Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. There may be occasional work on weekends or holidays.
- Occasional overnight work from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

What to expect

- Intermittent elevated noise.
- Continued trucking activities. Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Occasional night work, including lighting directed at the site as needed to ensure crew safety.
- Crane activity.
- Temporary traffic changes as required.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest work during the day and shoulder hours, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, using hand-tools when applicable, monitoring noisy activities so that mitigation measures can be adapted as needed, and directing lights away from residential buildings. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

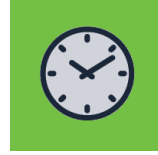

- This phase of construction is continuing through 2024.
- Station construction and fit out will complete in 2026.



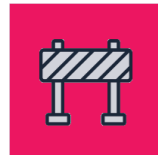
Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday, with occasional work on weekends or holidays: 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Occasional night work: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.



Traffic

- Closures:
 - Earl Finning Way between Fraser and Foley streets.
 - Foley Street north of parking access lane.
 - Fraser Street north of Great Northern Way is closed at E. 1st Avenue and Earl Finning Way.
- No parking:
 - Along the north side of Great Northern Way, from 565 Great Northern Way west to Thornton Street.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Intermittent elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, crane movement, deliveries, rebar installation, and concrete activities.
- Continued trucking activities. Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Cleanliness of the trucking route is managed by street sweepers.
- Lighting focused on our site as needed to ensure crew safety.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured around work zones as required.
