





Track installation underway on the elevated guideway

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the elevated guideway that will connect VCC-Clark Station to the future Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station. With construction of the elevated guideway structure complete, work is now focused on track installation.


Timing

- Regular hours of work are Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. There may be occasional work on weekends or holidays.
- Occasional overnight work from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

What to expect

- Some noise related to track installation work.
- Construction vehicles and crane activity.
- Possible temporary road or travel lane closures, and reduced speed limits.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest work during the day and shoulder hours, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment, and using hand-tools when applicable. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Timing

Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday with occasional weekend work: 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Occasional night work: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.



Traffic

- Closures:
 - Earl Finning Way between Fraser and Foley streets.
 - Foley Street north of parking access lane.
 - Fraser Street north side closed to E. 1st Avenue and Earl Finning Way.
- No parking:
 - Along the north side of Great Northern Way, from 565 Great Northern Way west to Thornton Street.
 - Along Earl Finning Way, Foley, and Fraser streets.
 - Drivers are encouraged to use existing parkades.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Intermittent elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, deliveries and track installation.
- Increase in construction vehicles and equipment.
- Lighting focused on our site as needed to ensure crew safety.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured around work zones as required.
