





Underground construction progresses at the future OAK-VGH Station through the summer – includes intermittent night work

July 19, 2024

The future Oak-VGH Station is taking shape in your neighbourhood. The tunnel boring machines passed through the Oak-VGH Station at the end of 2023, and since then Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) crews have focused on the construction of the underground station structure. Ongoing site activities include rebar installation, delivery of materials and equipment, utilities maintenance, road and sidewalk repairs, and regular concrete pours. To complete this work efficiently, we will continue working primarily during the day and intermittently overnight along W. Broadway between Laurel and Oak streets. We remain committed to keeping residents and businesses updated on our progress as we advance this major transit infrastructure project in your community.

What to expect during daytime work

- Regular work hours are from Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work on Sunday and holidays.
- Some elevated noise related to specific activities.
- Temporary traffic changes and increased trucking activity related to the delivery of materials.
- Crane activity.
- Possible temporary lane closures and changes to pedestrian access to accommodate deliveries and trucking activity.

What to expect at night

- When overnight work is required, work hours can range from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. We will continue to provide updates as work progresses.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up signals on equipment where possible, installing noise barriers around sources of noise, conducting the noisiest activities during the day, directing lights away from residential buildings, and monitoring activities to adapt mitigations as needed to minimize impacts on our neighbours. When travelling through construction zones, please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Timing

 Station construction will continue through 2026.



Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. There may be occasional work on Sundays or holidays.
- When overnight work is required, work hours can range from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 We will continue to provide updates as work progresses.



Traffic

- Regular temporary lane closures on W. Broadway on weekdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m., overnight or on weekends to support construction activities.
- Temporary lane closures on W. Broadway, Oak Street and Laurel Street may be implemented to support concrete pour activities.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Some elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, rebar installation, crane movement, and deliveries.
- Concrete trucks are required to keep their engines running to keep their drums turning and use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials during the day or night and concrete pour activities.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety
