





Construction inside the tunnels continues through the fall and winter

September 12, 2024

The future Millennium Line extension is taking shape in your neighbourhood underground. Tunnel boring activities were completed in Spring 2024, and the tunnel boring machines and supporting equipment have been disassembled and removed. Throughout the fall and winter, work will continue inside the tunnels to build the concrete base for track installation and install track and other systems. As well, crews are excavating and building the multiple service passages between the twin tunnels. While crews work inside the tunnels, ventilation fans will be in operation at each station as they play a crucial role in maintaining optimal air quality within the tunnels.

While tunnel activities take place below ground, some activities such as soil and debris removal, concrete pours, and material deliveries will require equipment operating at street level at the future station sites.

We remain committed to keeping residents and businesses updated on our progress as we advance this major transit infrastructure project in your community.

What to expect during daytime work

- Regular work hours are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work on Sundays and holidays.
- Some elevated noise at street level related to the ventilation fans.
- For specific activity and hours of work at the station site nearest you, check the notification for that site.

We strive to minimize impacts of construction activities on our neighbours, and we are regularly monitoring and adapting mitigations as needed. See below for further information.

When travelling through construction zones, please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Construction Activities

- Excavation of service passages between tunnels, and trucking of material.
- Deliveries of materials, including trucking and crane activities at station sites.
- Concrete pours at station sites.
- Installing tracks in the tunnels (starting late fall).



Impacts

- Some elevated noise at street level related to the ventilation fans.
- For specific impacts at the station site nearest you, check the notification for that site.



Traffic

Temporary lane closures on W. Broadway between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m., overnight or on weekends may be implemented to support construction activities and deliveries.



Mitigations

- Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:
 - Noise barriers installed around some sources of noise.
 - White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
 - Directing lights away from residential buildings.
