



Construction of the South Granville Station continues through fall 2024 includes night work

September 19, 2024

The future South Granville Station is taking shape in your neighbourhood. With the first escalators installed and significant work completed in the station, crews are focused on constructing the second station level of the station under the traffic deck. To complete this work efficiently, we will continue working primarily during the day with regular night work. We remain committed to keeping residents and businesses updated on our progress as we advance this major transit project in your community.

What to expect during daytime work

- Typical hours of work are from Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work • that starts earlier or work on Sunday and holidays.
- Some elevated noise during specific activities.
- Temporary traffic changes and increased trucking activity related to materials delivery and concrete pours. •
- Pedestrians will be detoured around work as required. •

What to expect at night

- Regular night work is ongoing; hours can range from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety. ٠

We strive to minimize impacts of construction activities on our neighbours, and we are regularly monitoring and adapting mitigations as needed.

When travelling through construction zones, please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Construction Activities

- Concrete pours.
- Deliveries of materials using trucks and cranes.
- Welding, waterproofing, rebar installation, mechanical and electrical work and carpentry under the traffic deck.
- Activities to support construction inside the tunnels.
- Utility relocation in the laneway between Hemlock and Granville streets.
- Station construction is expected to continue through 2026.



Traffic

 Regular temporary lane restrictions on W. Broadway on weekdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m., overnight or on weekends to support construction activities.

BROADWAY Subway Project Corporation

- Temporary lane closures on
 W. Broadway, Hemlock Street and
 8th Avenue may be implemented to
 support concrete pour activities.
- Temporary turning restrictions at Granville Street to support some activities.



Impacts

- Some elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, rebar installation, crane movement, ventilation fans and deliveries.
- During concrete pours, trucks are required to keep their engines running to keep their drums turning and use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials during the day or night and concrete pour activities.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.



Mitigations

- Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:
 - Noise barriers installed around some sources of noise.
 - White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
 - Directing lights away from residential buildings.
 - Using quieter models of equipment at night, such as hand tools.
