





Attention Drivers: Additional Turning Restrictions for Large Tractor and Semi-trailers in Effect March 14 at Arbutus and W. Broadway



The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is implementing traffic changes at Arbutus St. and W. Broadway as it builds the Broadway Subway Project.

Beginning March 14, large tractor semi-trailer-type trucks WILL NOT be able to make left hand turns from eastbound and westbound W. Broadway onto Arbutus St. This latest restriction is in addition to not being able to make right or left hand turns onto W. Broadway from northbound Arbutus St., in effect since December 19, 2021. Trucks will need to take alternate trucking routes available via Oak St., Mackenzie/Macdonald streets, or Dunbar St. to access W. Broadway.

Please see the truck access route map below, which includes signage identifying trucks that will be subject to the turning restrictions. These turn restrictions will be in place 24/7 until the end of the project.

Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
