

## Overnight concrete pour at Broadway-City Hall Station on October 30

October 28, 2024

The future Broadway-City Hall station is taking shape in your neighbourhood. A key part of this phase of construction is concrete work to build the walls, columns of roofs of the station. The next concrete pour has been scheduled to start the evening of October 30 and continue into early the next morning. This concrete pour requires lane closures to accommodate equipment on W. Broadway. The work has been timed to minimize traffic impacts on W. Broadway and Cambie Street during peak periods.

### Timing

- Work hours: Starting at 6:30 p.m. on October 30 and continuing until 4 a.m. on October 31.
- Regular work hours are Monday to Saturday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work on Sundays and holidays.

### What to expect

- Increased construction trucks in the neighbourhood; this pour requires between 12 and 14 concrete trucks.
- Some elevated noise related to concrete work. Concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Lighting directed at the site to ensure crew safety.
- One lane of traffic on W. Broadway will be maintained in each direction between Yukon and Columbia streets.
- Concrete activities will be focused on W. Broadway near Alberta Street, including truck staging within the existing enclosure on W. Broadway.
- There will be additional concrete activities during regular work hours on October 31 and November 1 from within the Project site.

We strive to minimize impacts of construction activities on our neighbours, and we are regularly monitoring and adapting mitigations as needed. We remain committed to keeping residents and businesses updated on our progress as we advance this major transit infrastructure project in your community.
