





Excavation of emergency exit and ventilation shaft for Oak-VGH Station begins

November 29, 2024

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighborhood building the future Oak-VGH Station. As construction progresses, excavation of the ventilation shaft and emergency exit tunnel will begin on December 2, 2024. The emergency exit tunnel will connect the underground station to the surface through an adjacent property. This work is expected to be completed by the end of January 2025.

Mobilization for this work will require a temporary crane setup on W. Broadway, east of Oak Street, during the daytime on Monday, December 2, and Tuesday, December 3, to support the movement of equipment and materials onto the station. Once all materials are lowered into the excavation, this crane will be removed.


Timing

• Regular work hours are Monday to Saturday, from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.

What to expect

- Elevated noise from excavation, drilling, and concrete activities.
- Vibration.
- Increased trucking activity.
- The sidewalk will remain open for pedestrians and provide access to businesses, health services, and residences, as the work happens underground. The map below shows the work areas below the traffic deck in green.
