





Update on the Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station – includes intermittent night work

December 20, 2024

The future Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station is progressing in your neighborhood. The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) crews are focusing on the continued construction of the underground station and tunnels that connect to the elevated guideway. To complete this work efficiently, we will continue primarily working during the day, with occasional overnight work. We are committed to keeping residents and businesses informed as we advance this significant transit infrastructure project in your community.

What to expect during daytime work

- Regular work hours are from Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. There may be occasional work that starts earlier or work on Sunday and holidays.
- Some elevated noise during specific activities. See below for more information.
- As work areas become enclosed, ventilation fan activity has increased to comply with WorkSafeBC requirements. Fans will be active during all hours of work to ensure the safety of crews.
- Temporary traffic changes related to the delivery of materials.
- Temporary lane closures to accommodate deliveries and construction activity.
- Pedestrians will be detoured around work as required.

What to expect at night

- When overnight work is required; work hours can range from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m.
- Overnight lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.

We remain committed to keeping residents and businesses updated on our progress as we advance this major transit infrastructure project in your community.

When travelling through construction zones, please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Construction Activites

- Concrete pours.
- Crane activity.
- Deliveries of materials, including trucking and crane activities.
- Welding, waterproofing and rebar.
- Intermittent hydro vac.
- Track installation in the station and tunnels.
- Station construction is expected to continue through 2026.



Traffic

Closures:

- Earl Finning Way between Fraser and Foley streets.
- Foley Street north of parking access lane.
- Fraser Street north of Great Northern
 Way is closed at E. 1st Avenue and Earl
 Finning Way.
- Temporary lane closures on Great Northern Way during concrete pours.

No parking:

 Along the north side of Great Northern Way, from 565 Great Northern Way west to Thornton Street.



Impacts

- Some elevated noise related to activities that include, but are not limited to, rebar installation, crane movement, ventilation fans and deliveries.
- Concrete trucks are required to keep their engines running to keep their drums turning and use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.
- Lighting focused on our sites to ensure crew safety.
- Trucking activity to accommodate deliveries of equipment and materials and concrete pours.



Mitigations

Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to:

- Noise barriers installed around some sources of noise.
- White noise back-up signals on equipment when possible.
- Directing lights away from residential buildings.
- Using quieter models of equipment at night, such as hand tools.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
