

Oak-VGH Concrete Activities

February 14, 2025

Please be advised the Oak-VGH station crew will be conducting a large concrete pour on Saturday, February 22, 2025. This pour was initially scheduled for Friday, February 14, 2025.

Construction Activities

A concrete pour will take place:

- On Saturday, February 22, 2025; work hours are from 5 a.m. to 7 p.m., with the first concrete truck arriving on-site around 6 a.m. Low-noise work will continue into the evening to complete related activities.



What to expect

- The concrete pump will be located inside the station site. Concrete trucks will utilize the laneway south of W. Broadway, between Willow St. and Oak St., for truck access to the site.
- There will be approximately 70 trucks involved in this pour.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- Traffic control personnel will be on site to manage pedestrians, cyclists and concrete trucks.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained for all activities.
