





# Oak-VGH Concrete Activities

## February 7, 2025

Please see below an update on concrete activities beginning February 10 and continuing until February 28.



#### **Construction Activities**

Multiple concrete pours will take place:

From Monday, February 10 to Friday, February 28; work hours are Monday to Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., with the first concrete trucks arriving on-site daily around 7 a.m. Low-noise work will continue into the evening to complete related activities.



### What to expect

- The concrete pump will be located inside the W. Broadway and Oak Street laydown area. Concrete trucks will stage along Laurel Street and utilize the laneway south of W. Broadway, between Laurel Street and Oak Street, for access to the pump.
- There will be approximately 8-10 trucks involved per day.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.



#### Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- Parking will be restricted in the southbound parking lane on Laurel Street, Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. for the duration of this work.
- There may be closures of the east crosswalk at the Oak Street and W. Broadway intersection. Pedestrian detours will be implemented.
- Traffic control personnel will be on site to manage pedestrians, cyclists and concrete trucks.
- Access to businesses, health services, and residences will be maintained for all activities.
