



All-day concrete pour March 8 at the future Mount Pleasant Station

March 5, 2025

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation has scheduled a concrete pour at the future Mount Pleasant Station on Saturday, March 8. Further details are below.



Construction Activities

A concrete pour will take place on Saturday, March 8:

• Work hours are from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m. The first concrete truck will arrive on site around 6 a.m. Low-noise work will continue into the evening to complete related activities.



What to expect

- Two concrete pump trucks will be used for this concrete pour: one concrete pump truck will be set up on the west side of Main Street south of E. Broadway; the second concrete pump truck will be set up inside the construction site laydown.
- Approximately 126 concrete trucks will be involved in this pour.
- Please note that concrete trucks are required to have their engines running at all times to keep their drums turning, and to use traditional back-up alarms for crew safety.



Traffic

Temporary traffic changes may be in place during the concrete pour as follows:

- The southbound curb lane and the west sidewalk on Main Street south of E. Broadway toward mid-block will be closed from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Concrete trucks will arrive and leave from the construction site via E. 10th Avenue, Quebec Street and the lane running between Quebec and E. 10th Avenue.
- Parking and the loading zone on Quebec Street between E. 10 Avenue and the lane will <u>remain</u> <u>open</u> throughout this pour.
